Cost: \$5/person and the schedule will be as follows (approximate):

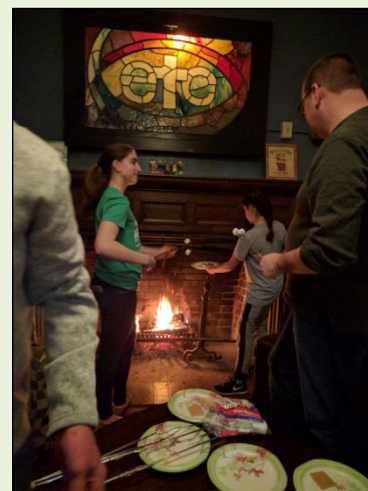
FRIDAY Schedule:
